Attach the following documents to substantiate your right to the funds on deposit:

- A copy of the decedent's will (if there is one)
- Decedent's death certificate
- Marriage certificate if you are the decedent's spouse
- Your birth certificate if you are the decedent's child
- If other than a spouse or child, provide documentary proof of the existence of a blood or legal relationship to either the decedent or his/her predeceased spouse that proves your right to the funds on deposit.

Please note: The documentary proof, if regular on its face, need not be certified. At least forty (40) days must have lapsed since the death.

Provide reasonable proof of your identity for purposes of this declaration as follows:

- An identification card or driver's license issued by the California Department of Motor Vehicles that is current or was issued during the preceding five years.
- A passport issued by the U.S. Department of State that is current or was issued during the preceding five years
- Any of the following documents that is current or was issued in the previous five years and contains a photograph, description of the person, is signed by the person, and bears a serial or other identifying number:
 - A passport issued by a foreign government that has been stamped by the United States Immigration and Naturalized Service
 - A driver's license issued by a state other than California
 - An Identification card issued by a state other than California
 - An Identification card issued by any branch of the armed forces of the United States

**If you are unable to execute this declaration in the presence of Treasurer-Tax Collector staff, a notary public's certificate of acknowledgement, identifying you as the person executing the declaration, is reasonable proof of identity.
