

RESOLUTION NO. 24-05
A RESOLUTION OF INTENTION TO FORM ZONE OF BENEFIT NO. 3
OF THE COLUSA COUNTY FLOOD CONTROL AND
WATER CONSERVATION DISTRICT

WHEREAS, the Colusa County Flood Control and Water Conservation District (District) was formed by the legislature in 1983, to provide for water conservation, development of water resources, and control of drainage, storm, flood, and other waters within the boundaries of Colusa County; and

WHEREAS, the Sites Project Authority is in the process of planning and constructing Sites Reservoir in western Colusa County and therefore is within the boundaries of the District; and

WHEREAS, the District is proposed to serve as a regional entity to contract with the Sites Project Authority on behalf of both participating landowners within water districts not directly participating in the Sites Project as well as participating landowners not within any water district (white areas). The term “participating landowner” refers to a landowner currently participating in the Sites Project through their home water district or other mechanism, and does not include landowners not currently involved in the Project; and

WHEREAS, it is the intent of this District to form Zone of Benefit No. 3 (Zone 3) the jurisdictional boundaries of which are defined in the map attached hereto as Attachment “A”, for the purpose of facilitating participation in the Sites Project by participating landowners in the Zone 3 boundary and not otherwise represented in the Sites Project (Zone 3 Participants); and

WHEREAS, the estimated annual cost for Zone 3 facilitation of participation in the Sites Project, not including the cost of storage capacity, is \$270,000; and

WHEREAS, only Zone 3 Participants who have executed a Benefits and Obligations Contract between the landowner and the District will be charged any of the annual costs or costs of storage capacity;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Directors of the Colusa County Flood Control and Water Con-

servations District that on February 27, 2024, at the hour of 9:30 a.m. in the Board of Supervisors Chambers of the Colusa County Courthouse, a public hearing shall be held to consider formation of the proposed Zone 3, and that any interested person, including all persons owning land within the proposed Zone 3 jurisdiction, may appear and be heard. Any formal protest must be made in writing and submitted at the hearing; protest forms will be made available at the hearing.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a copy of the Resolution of intent to form Zone 3 shall be published in the Pioneer Review, a newspaper of general circulation, pursuant to Government Code section 6066, with the first publication to be at least 14 days prior to the time fixed for the public hearing.
