

REPORTING WELL PROBLEMS

In an effort to assess drought impacts and general groundwater conditions, the Colusa County Water Resources Department (Department of Agriculture) is compiling information on well problems county-wide. This information will help in our ongoing efforts to gain a better understanding of the local groundwater system. We are gathering information on **all well types** (domestic, irrigation, other) **and all well issues**, whether drought-related or mechanical. If you are experiencing problems with your water well, please take a few minutes to fill out the “Report of Well Problems” form which can be found on the County of Colusa website at www.countyofcolusa.org/DocumentCenter/View/5810. This reporting is voluntary and specific well locations will not be made public.

If you are a private homeowner with a domestic well that has lost water due to drought, you may be eligible to participate in a Household Water Tank Program. For more information on this program, contact the Colusa County Sheriff’s Office of Emergency Services at 530-458-0218.
