

IMPARTIAL ANALYSIS BY LOCAL AGENCY FORMATION COMMISSION  
OF MEASURE TO FORM WILLIAMS SPECIAL RECREATION DISTRICT

Heretofore, the Swimming Pool and other Recreation Services in the Williams area have been provided under a joint agreement between the Williams Unified School District and the City of Williams.

The Board of Supervisors has called this Election to form a separate entity for this purpose, under the Recreation and Park Districts Law, Chapter 4 (Commencing at Section 5780) of Division 5 of the Public Resources Code, to be called the Williams Special Recreation District. The boundaries of the District are to be the same as and coterminous with the boundaries of the Williams Unified School District.

If formation of the District is approved, there will be established for said District an annual Special Tax Rate as follows:

<u>Dwelling Unit</u>	<u>Rate Per Unit</u>
Single family residence (1 unit)	\$36.00
Duplex (2 units)	36.00
Fourplex (4 units)	36.00
Apartment house complex (more than 4 units)	36.00

Also there will be established an annual Appropriation Limit of \$34,300.00.

A "YES" vote on the Measure is a vote to form the District, to establish the annual Special Tax Rate and to establish the annual Appropriation Limit.

A "NO" vote on the Measure is a vote to deny formation of the District, to deny establishment of the annual Special Tax Rate and to deny establishment of the annual Appropriation Limit.
