

For each Assessor's parcel of land upon which there is no Residence: \$3.00 or seven cents (\$0.07) per acre, whichever sum is the greater, per year, all said assessments to be collected along with County taxes?

Section 2. At the Election herein called and ordered to be held in said proposed District as aforesaid, there shall be elected a Board of Directors for said District of five members who, if said District is formed, shall hold office, pursuant to Section 23506 of the Elections Code, until noon on the last Friday in November, 1989 and until their successors are duly elected and qualified.

Section 3. The Election ordered by this Resolution shall be held and conducted, the votes received and canvassed and the result thereof ascertained in the manner provided by the Uniform District Election Law (Section 23500 et seq. of the Elections Code) for the holding of General District Elections.






