PETITION FOR FORMATION OF
STONYFORD RECREATION DISTRICT

ORDER DECLARING FORMATION OF
STONYFORD RECREATION DISTRICT

WHEREAS, a Special District election within the boundaries of proposed Stonyford Recreation District was held according to law on November 6, 1984, for the purpose of determining whether or not the District should be formed, to establish a revenue limit, to levy an assessment, and to elect five (5) Directors to be the first Directors of the Stonyford Recreation District; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined pursuant to Government Code Section 54790.3 that no property tax revenue is to be exchanged between affected districts because the Stonyford Recreation District will provide a new service and will not assume responsibility for service from any other special district or governmental agency; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Election Code Section 23547 the Board of Election for such election delivered the ballots, voters list and roster of voters to the Colusa County Clerk and Glenn County Clerk, and the Colusa County Clerk canvassed such returns and issued a Certificate of Results of Election dated November 21, 1984, in accordance with the Uniform District Election Law; and

WHEREAS, this Board has additionally canvassed the returns and finds them to be as reported in the Colusa County Clerk's Certificate of Results (Exhibit B) and further finds that at least a majority of all votes cast favor the formation of the district, the establishment of a revenue limit, and the election of Lawrence J. Moore, Al A. Stanchina, Barbara Cook, Darryl F. Bond, and D. E. Dawson as the first Directors of the Stonyford Recreation District, while disapproving the levy of an annual assessment;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Stonyford Recreation District is hereby ordered and declared formed under the name "Stonyford Recreation District" and encompassing the territory described on Exhibit "A" attached hereto and incorporated by reference;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the County Clerk as Ex Officio Clerk of the Board of Supervisors immediately transmit a certified copy of this Order Declaring Formation for record in the

office of the Local Agency Formation Commission of Colusa County pursuant to Government Code Section 54797.2, and issue Certificates of Election to Lawrence J. Moore, Al A. Stanchina, Barbara Cook, Daryl F. Bond, and D. E. Dawson, each as Directors of the Stonyford Recreation District.

The foregoing Resolution was passed and adopted by the Colusa County Board of Supervisors on December 4, 1984 by the following vote:

EXHIBIT "A"

STONYFORD RECREATION DISTRICT

The Stonyford Recreation District, a district within Colusa County and Glenn County described as follows. Beginning at the Northeast corner of Section 28, Township 17 North, Range 5 West of the M.D.B. and M., which point is the true point of beginning of the district to be described; thence Southerly upon the easterly boundaries of Sections 28 and 33 of the afore said Township 17 North, Range 5 West, M.D.B. and M. to the Southeast corner of the afore said Section 33, which corner is also the Northeast corner of Section 4, Township 16 North, Range 5 West, M.D.B. and M.; thence Southerly upon the easterly boundaries of Sections 4,9,16,21,28 and 33 to the Southeast corner of Section 33, Township 16 North, Range 5 West, M.D.B. and M., which corner is upon the Third Standard Parallel North; thence Easterly upon the afore said Third Standard Parallel North to the Northeast corner of Section 4, Township 15 North, Range 5 West, M.D.B. and M.; thence Southerly upon the easterly boundaries of Sections 4,9,16, and 21 to the Southeast corner of Section 21 to the Southeast corner of Section 21, Township 15 North, Range 5 West, M.D.B. and M.; thence Southerly upon the easterly boundary of Section 28, Township 15 North, Range 5 West, M.D.B. and M. to an intersection with the center line of Freshwater Creek; thence Southerly upon the center line of Freshwater Creek to the intersection of the southerly boundary of Section 34, Township 15 North, Range 5 West, M.D.B. and M.; thence Westerly upon the southerly boundary of Sections 34,33,32 and 31 of Township 15 North, Range 5 West, M.D.B. and M. to the Southeast corner of Section 36, Township 15 North, Range 6 West, M.D.B. and M.; thence Westerly upon the southerly boundaries of Section 36 and Section 35 to the westerly boundary of Colusa County, which is the ridge of the summit line of the Coast Range, being the easterly boundary of Lake County; thence Northerly upon the westerly boundary of Colusa County to the Northwest corner of Colusa County, which corner is the intersection of the ridge of the summit line of the Coast Range with the northerly boundary of the South Half of Section 29, Township 18 North, Range 8 West, M.D.B. and M.; thence Easterly upon the northerly boundary of Colusa County to the East Quarter corner of Section 25, Township 18 North, Range 7 West, M.D.B. and M.; thence Northerly upon the easterly boundaries of Sections 25,24,13,12 and Section 1 all in Township 18 North, Range 7 West, M.D.B. and M. to the Northeast corner of the afore said Section 1; thence Westerly upon the northerly boundary of afore said Section 1 to the Northwest corner of the afore said Section 1, which corner is also the Southwest corner of Section 36, Township 19 North, Range 7 West, M.D.B. and M.; thence Northerly upon the westerly boundaries of Sections 36, 25, 24 and Section 13 to the Northwest corner of Section 13, Township 19 North, Range 7 West, M.D.B. and M.; thence Easterly upon the northerly boundary of the afore said Section 13 to the Northeast corner afore said Section 13, which corner is also the Northwest corner of Section 18, Township 19 North, Range 6 West, M.D.B. and M.; thence Easterly upon the northerly boundaries of Sections 18,17,16,15,14 and 13 to the Northeast corner of Section 13, Township 19 North, Range 6 West, M.D.B. and M., which is also the Northwest corner of Section 18, Township 19 North Range 5 West of the M.D.B. and M.; thence Easterly upon the northerly boundaries of Sections 18, 17, 16, and 15 afore said township and range to the Northeast corner of the afore said Section 15; thence Southerly upon the easterly boundaries of Sections 15,22,27 and 34 to the Southeast corner of Section 34, Township 19 North, Range 5 West, M.D.B. and M.; thence Westerly upon the southerly boundary afore said Section 34 to the Southwest corner afore said Section 34; which corner is also the Northeast corner of Section 4, Township 18 North, Range 5 West, M.D.B. and M.; thence Southerly upon the easterly boundaries of Sections 4,9,16 and 21 to the Southeast corner of afore said Section 21; thence Westerly upon the southerly boundary afore said Section 21 to the North Quarter corner of Section 29, Township 18 North, Range 5 West, M.D.B. and M.; thence Southerly upon the Midsection lines of Section 29 and Section 32, Township 18 North, Range 5 West, M.D.B. and M. to the North Quarter corner of Section 5, Township 17 North, Range 5 West, M.D.B. and M.; thence Southerly upon the Midsection lines of Sections 5,8,17 and Section 20 to the South

Quarter corner of Section 20, Township 17 North, Range 5 West, M.D.B. and M.; which corner is also the North Quarter corner of Section 29, Township 17 North, Range 5 West, M.D.B. and M.; thence Easterly upon the northerly boundaries of Section 29 and Section 28 to the Northeast corner of Section 17 North, Range 5 West M.D.B. and M., which corner was the point of beginning of the afore said Stonyford Recreation District-EXCEPTING the following described tracts:

Those tracts in Township 15 North, Range 5 West of the M.D.B. and M. described as follows:

That portion of the South half of the Southwest quarter of Fractional Section 5, lying Westerly of the following described line, to-wit: Beginning at a point which is West 12 chains from the quarter section corner between Sections 5 and 8 and running thence N. 42° W. 27.50 chains to the North line of the South half of the Southwest Quarter of said Section 5.

Government Lot 12, the Southeast quarter of the Southwest quarter and the South half of the Southeast quarter of Fractional Section 6 and that portion of the Northeast quarter of the Southwest quarter and the North half of the Southeast quarter of said Section 6 lying Southerly of the following described line, to wit:

Beginning at the Northeast corner of the Southeast quarter of said Section 6 and running thence Southwesterly to a point on the line running Northerly and Southerly through the Southwest quarter of said Section 6, which is North 0.91 chains from the Southwest corner of the Northeast quarter of the Southwest quarter of said Section 6.

The Whole of Fractional Section 7.

The South Half of Section 8 all all of that part of the Northwest quarter of Section 8 lying westerly of Bear Valley Road.

The Southwest quarter of Section 9.

The Whole of Section 16.

The Whole of Section 17.

All of Fractional Section 18 EXCEPT for Government lot 4.

All of Fractional Section 19 EXCEPT for Government Lots 2, 3 and 4.

All of Section 20 EXCEPT for the East half of the Southeast quarter.

The North Half of Section 21.

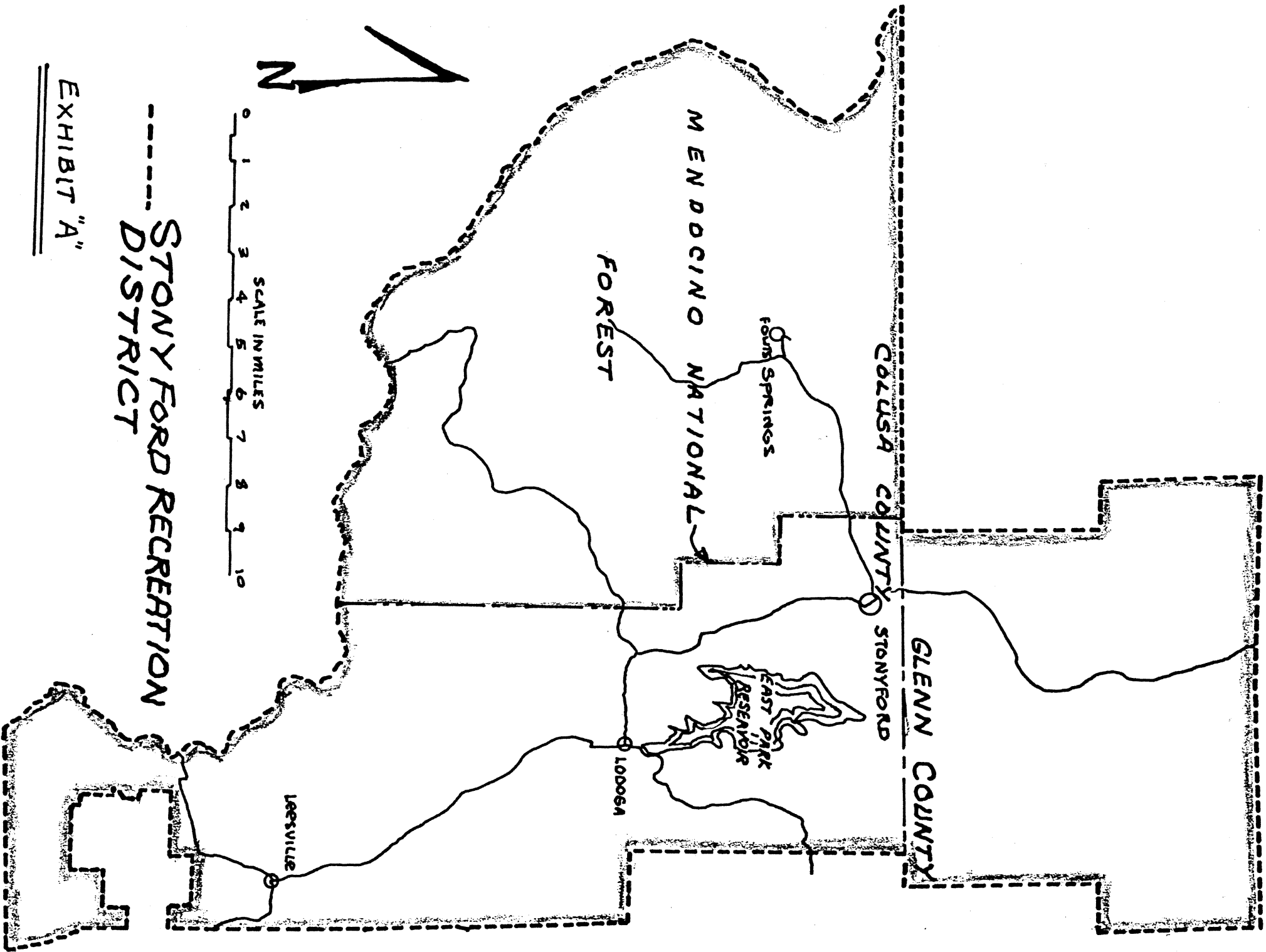
The North half of the Northwest quarter and the Northwest quarter of the Northeast quarter of Section 29.

The Northeast quarter of the Northwest quarter and the North half of the Northeast quarter of Section 30.

Those tracts in Township 15 North, Range 6 West of the M.D.B. and M. described as follows:

That part of Fractional Section 1 being the South half EXCEPT for Northwest quarter of the Southwest quarter, the Northeast quarter of the Southeast quarter, and the East half of the Northwest quarter of the Southeast quarter and EXCEPTING any part of the afore said South half which is in Lake County.

That part of Section 12 lying in Colusa County except for the Southwest quarter of the Southeast quarter, the Southwest quarter, and the South half of the Northwest quarter.
