RESOLUTION CALLING ADVISORY ELECTION AND SUBMITTING ADVISORY
MEASURE TO THE RESIDENT VOTERS WITHIN THE PROPOSED
BOUNDARIES OF A COMMUNITY SERVICE AREA AND/OR
COMMUNITY FACILITIES DISTRICT

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of Colusa County passed and adopted resolution number 87-59 for the purpose of submitting an advisory measure to the resident voters of the County; and

WHEREAS, the resolution was deficient in several particulars which require that said resolution be rescinded and this resolution be adopted in its place; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of Colusa County has received a recommendation from Office of Emergency Services that a County Community Service Area be formed within Colusa County for the purpose of providing extended ambulance service with EMT-2 rating, as shown on the Map attached hereto and marked Exhibit "A", as authorized pursuant to the provisions of the County Service Area Law and California Government Code Sections 25210 et seq. and California Government Code Sections 53311 et seq., known as the Mello-Roos Community Facilities Act of 1982; and

WHEREAS, before making a decision upon the proposal to form a County Wide Service Area as set forth in Exhibit "A", this Board deems it to be in the best interests of the County residents to obtain an expression of a non-binding opinion upon the issues from as many of the affected Resident Voters as possible; and

WHEREAS, Section 5353 of the California Elections Code authorizes this Board to accomplish this object by holding an Advisory Election for the purpose of allowing Voters within the boundaries of the proposed County Service Area to voice their opinion upon these issues;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of

Supervisors of Colusa County as follows:

Resolution 87-59 is hereby rescinded.

Section 1. An Advisory Election is hereby called and ordered to be held on November 3, 1987, in consolidation with the Uniform District Election Law Election regularly scheduled to be held on said date, within the portion of the proposed Colusa County Service Area designated upon the Map attached hereto and marked Exhibit "A".

Section 2. At said Advisory Election, the following Measures shall be submitted to the Eligible Voters residing within the boundaries shown on Exhibit "A" attached hereto:

MEASURE "D": Should the County in conjunction with the incorporated Cities of Williams and Colusa form a County Wide Service Area and/or a Community Facilities District for the purpose of providing Ambulance Service to the entire unincorporated and incorporated areas of the County of Colusa, the cost of which is estimated to be approximately \$106,000.00 per year for the basic service.

MEASURE "E": Should the County in conjunction with the incorporated Cities of Williams and Colusa form a County Wide Service Area and/or a Community Facilities District for the purpose of providing a miscellaneous extended Ambulance Service in addition to the basic service to provide EMT-2 Staff Rating; the estimated cost of which is \$75,000.00.

Section 3. The Advisory Election hereby called shall be a Resident Voter Election as set forth in Sections 23500 et seq. of the California Government Code.

Section 4. Said Advisory Election shall be conducted in conformance with the provisions of the Uniform District Election Law and the California Elections Code.

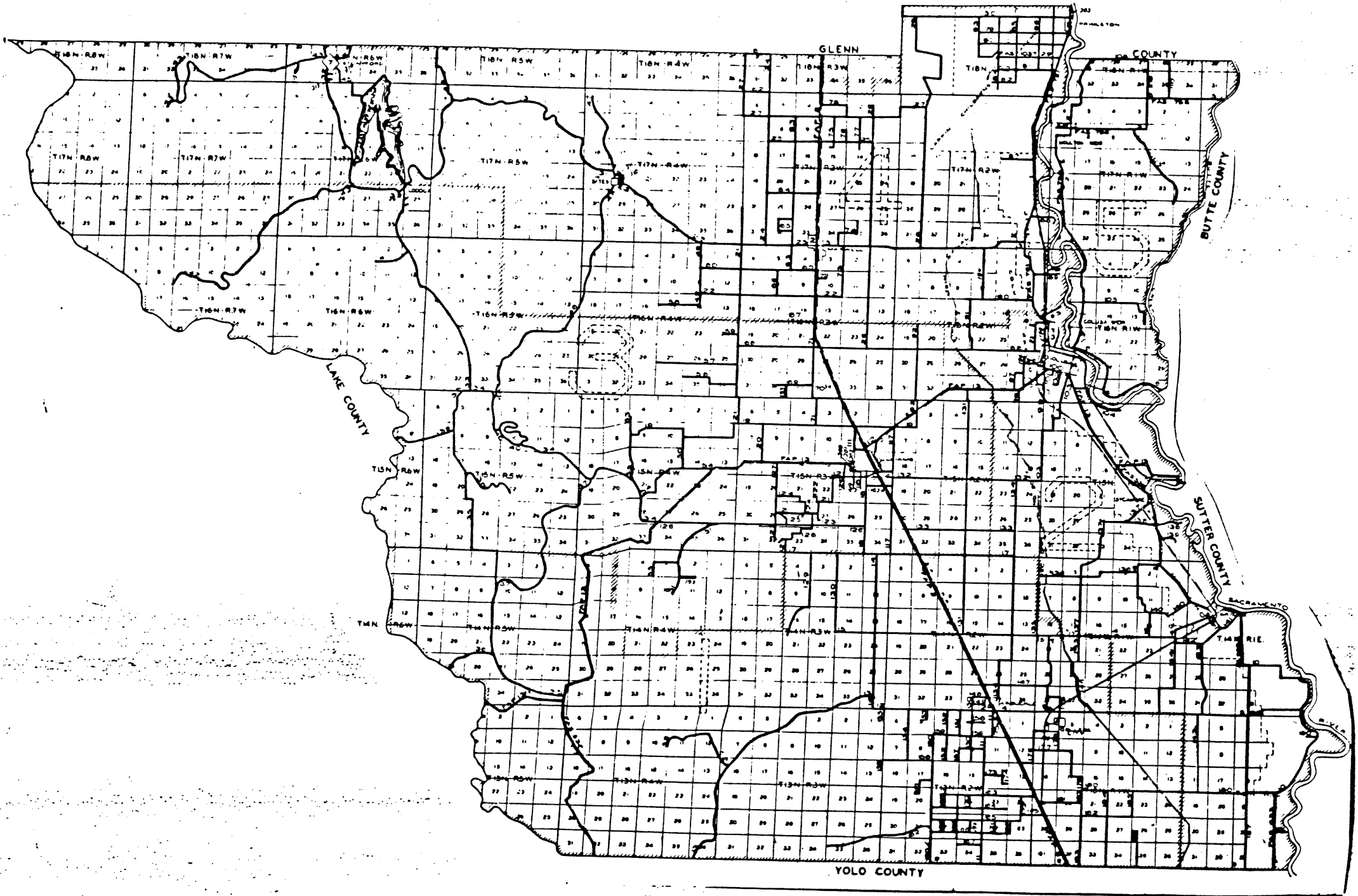
